Community Indicators Selected

After 8 months of work by our wonderful Community Indicators Advisory Committee, 54 indicators have been selected for our new program "Measuring What Matters for Kaua"i." Indicators selected provide a snapshot of how the island is doing in a variety areas, including economy, education, natural environment, land use and rural character, neighborhood and community well-being, health and wellness, public safety, civic engagement, and cultures and arts. The indicators will be measured, tracked over time, and reported annually so we can determine Kaua'i's progress toward achieving the community vision in the *General Plan 2000*. Training for Substance Abuse Counselors Concludes

Last week saw the final training in a series of 11 sessions held to train substance abuse counselors and mental health professionals on the island. A recent trainer was nationally-renowned expert Dr. Darryl Inaba, Executive Director of Haight Ashbury Clinic in California. A total of 103 people participated in the 7-month program, funded by the U.S. Department of Justice through the Hawai'i Community Foundation. This training was in response to KPAA's goal to mitigate drug use on the island and is one of the activities in the *Kaua'i Community Response Drug Plan 2004-2009*, prepared by KPAA.
